

The Tulalip Tribes Health Clinic (near Seattle, Washington) is currently looking for a full-time Family Practice physician to work for the ambulatory/Primary Care clinic. One of the physicians is retiring at the end of June. The Health Clinic Administrator at Tulalip is interested in having a PHS Medical Officer to work for the clinic. PHS Officers are eligible to work for the clinic through a Memorandum of Agreement with Indian Health Service (IHS) Portland Area office. There is current one PHS Officer working on site.

The Tulalip Health Clinic, a Native American tribal-run clinic, is located just little over 30 miles north of Seattle, Washington. The clinic, situated right next to the Tulalip Bay, has the state of the art facilities, including X-ray, dental clinic, and a STAT lab that runs CBC, UA, cardiac enzyme, chemistry panels, and more! Currently, there are 2 Family Practice Physicians, 1 Internist, 1 Pediatrician, and 3 Family Nurse Practitioner. The clinic has a very good collaborative practice between all providers, nurses and medical assistants.
